

[Genesis] cont 32

Gen 35:9 And God appeared unto Jacob again, who he came out of Padan-aram, and blessed him.

Gen 35:10 And God said unto him, Thy name is Jacob: thy name shall not be called any more Jacob, but Israel shall be thy name; and he called his name Israel.

Gen 35:11 And God said unto him:

I AM GOD ALMIGHTY: be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy loins;

Gen 35:12 And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give the land.

Gen 35:13 And God went up from him in the place where he talked with him.

Gen 35:14 And Jacob set up a pillar in the place where he talked with him, even a pillar of stone: and he poured a drink offering thereon, and he poured oil thereon.

Gen 35:15 And Jacob called the name of the place where God spoke with him, Beth-el.

Gen 35:16-18 Benjamin is born.

Gen 35:19 And Rachel died, and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which is Beth-lehem.

Gen 35:20 And Jacob set a pillar upon her grave: that is the pillar of Rachel's grave unto this day.

[Genesis] cont 34

Gen 38 Tamar plays the harlot and deceives Judah.

Gen 39:1-9 Joseph became the leader of Potiphar's house.

Gen 39:5 And it came to pass from the time that he had made him the overseer in his house, and over all that he had, that the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the LORD was upon all that he had in the house, and in the field.

Gen 39:7-19 Potiphar's wife tempts Joseph and falsely accuses him.

Gen 39:20 And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners were bound: and he was there in the prison.

Gen 39:21 But the LORD was with Joseph, and cleared him every way, and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison.

Gen 39:22 And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph his hand all the prisoners, that were in the prison; and whatever they did there, he was the doer of it.

Gen 39:23 The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing that was under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and that which he did, the LORD made it to prosper.

Gen 35:28 And the days of Isaac were one hundred and fourscore years.

Gen 35:29 And Isaac gave up the ghost and died, and was gathered unto his people, being old and full of days; and his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.

Gen 36 The generations of Esau

Gen 36:1 Now these are the generations of Esau, who is Edom.

Gen 37:1 And Jacob dwelt in the land wherein his father was a stranger, in the land of Canaan.

Gen 37:3 Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age: and he made him a coat of many colours.

Gen 37:4 And when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brother, they hated him.

Gen 37:5-17 Joseph was desirous that they portray him as ruler over his family.

Gen 37:18-27 ... they conspired to slay Joseph and threw him into a pit.

Gen 37:28-35 Joseph is sold into slavery.

Gen 37:36 And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh's, and captain of the guard.

Gen 37:28 Joseph is sold for 20 pieces of silver

Gen 40:1 And it came to pass after these things,

that the butler of the king of Egypt and his baker had offended their lord the king of Egypt.

Gen 40:2-3 Pharaoh put them in prison.

Gen 40:4 And the captain of the guard charged Joseph with them, and he served them: and they continued a season in ward.

Gen 40:5 And they dreamed a dream both of them:

Gen 40:8 And they said unto him, We have dreamed a dream, and there is no interpreter of it. And Joseph said unto them, Do not interpretations belong to God? tell me then I pray you.

Gen 40:9 And the chief butler told his dream to Joseph: ... a vine with 3 branches.

Gen 40:10-15 Joseph foretold the butler returned to Pharaoh as before.

Gen 40:14 But this is one whom it shall be well with thee, and when thou art free, I pray thee unto me, and make me know of me to Pharaoh.

Gen 40:16-17 The chief baker told his dream, and he had three white baskets on his head.

Gen 40:17-19 Joseph foretold the baker in hang'd

Gen 40:20-22 After three days, Pharaoh restores the chief butler, and hangs the chief baker ... as Joseph had interpreted to them.

Gen 40:23 Yet did not the chief butler remember Joseph, but forgat him.
