Jos 1:1-4 The LORD appoints Joshua to succeed Moses.

Jos 1:1 Now after the death of Moses, the servant of the LORD, it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, "I will give you the land of Canaan." Jos 1:5-9 GOD promises to assist Joshua.

Jos 1:10-15 Preparation to pass over Jordan.

Jos 1:16-18 The people promise to obey Joshua.

Jos 2 Rahab receives and hides the two spies from Israel. They promise to protect her and family.

Jos 3 The LORD parts the Jordan River, and the Israelites pass through Jordan on dry land.

Jos 3:7 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that thou may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee.

Jos 4 Twelve stones removed from the middle of Jordan River, on dry ground, for a memorial.

Jos 4:22 Then ye shall let your children know, saying, Israel came over this Jordan on dry land.

Jos 5 The Captain of the LORD's host appears to Joshua.

[Joshua] cont. 2

Jos 9 The Gibeonites deceive Joshua's men and are spared, to become servants of Israel.

Jos 10 The five kings of the Amorites were against Gibeon and Israel... and are defeated by Joshua.

Jos 10:12-14 Joshua commands the Sun and the moon to stand still.

Jos 10:14 And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.

Jos 11 The LORD defeats the rest of the kings, in the promised land, through Joshua and Israel.

Jos 11:23... And the land rested from war.

Jos 12 31 kings conquered by Moses & Joshua.

Jos 13:1-6 Bounds of the land not yet conquered.

Jos 13:7-33 Inheritance of Reuben.

Jos 14 Nine and one half tribes given land west of Jordan River.

Jos 14:4 The children of Joseph were two tribes: Menasseh and Ephraim. Levites given no land except cities to live in, for their inheritance was the LORD.

Jos 14:6-15 Caleb obtains Hebron as he was promised.

Jos 15 Inheritance of Judah.

Jos 16 The portion of Manasseh and Ephraim

Jos 15 And the Captain of the LORD's host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot, for the place wherein thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so.

Jos 16 The walls of Jericho fall down.

Jos 16:1-5 The siege of Jericho

Jos 16:6-16 The city is compassed.

Jos 16:17-27 Jericho is taken, Rahab and her family are saved.

Jos 7 Achan, of the tribe of Judah, takes a part of the accursed thing. Israel is punished in warfare.

Jos 7:16-26 Achan is discovered and destroyed by stoning and burning for his crime.

Jos 8 GOD encourages Joshua and instructs him to lay an ambush and take the city of Ai and its king.

Jos 8:1 And the LORD said unto Joshua Fear not, neither be thou dismayed: take all the people

of war with thee, and arise, go up to Ai: see I have given into thy hand the King of Ai, and his people, and his city, and his land:

Jos 8:2 ... lay thee an ambush for the city behind it.

Jos 17 More detail on Manasseh

Jos 18 Seven tribes remain to receive land.

Jos 18:11-28 Benjamin - boundaries

Jos 19 Lots of Simeon, Zebulun, Issachar, Asher, Naphtali, and Dan.

Jos 19:49-50 Land of Joshua, son of Nun.

Jos 19:51 So they made an end of dividing the country.

Jos 20 The six cities of refuge.

Jos 21 48 cities given to the Levites out of the tribes of Israel.

Jos 21:45 There failed not ought of any good thing which the LORD had spoken unto the house of Israel; all came to pass!!

Jos 22 Reuben, Gad, & tribe of Manasseh build an altar of testimony. Israel is offended in fear of wrath from GOD. They explain to Israel that it is testimony to GOD, not an altar.

Jos 23 Joshua's farewell & warning to Israel.

Jos 24:15-28 Joshua renews the covenant between the people and GOD.

Jos 24:29 And it came to pass after these things that Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died, being an hundred and ten years old. 110

Jos 24:31 Israel served the LORD all the days of Joshua.

Jos 24:32 The bones of Joseph buried in Shechem. 110 yrs also
