

Psalm 5

10-12-18

Psa 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh Not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

Psa 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in HIS Law doth he meditate day and night.

⇒ Psa 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous; but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

+ Psa 2 The presenting of JEHOVAH's Anointed as rejected, crucified, and set as king in Zion.

Psa 3:3 But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

◇ Psa 3:5 I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the LORD sustained me.

→ Psa 4:3 But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for HIMSELF: the LORD will hear when I call unto HIM.

⇒ Psa 4:5 Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD.

◇ Psa 5:11 But let all those who put their trust in THEE rejoice: ...

◇ Psa 5:12 For THOU, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt THOU compass him as with a shield

Psalm 9 cont. 2

Psa 9:1 I will praise THEE, O LORD, with my whole heart.

Psa 9:7 But the LORD shall endure for ever: HE hath prepared his throne for judgement.

Psa 10 The ways of the wicked.

Psa 11:4 The LORD is in HIS holy temple, the LORD's throne is in heaven...

Psa 11:5 The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence HIS soul hateth.

⇒ Psa 9:9 The LORD shall also be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.

* Psa 12:6 The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.

Psa 13:1-4 David and his enemies

◇ Psa 13:5 But I have trusted in thy Mercy; my heart shall rejoice in THY Salvation.

Psa 13:6 I will sing unto the LORD, because HE hath dealt bountifully with me.

* Psa 14:1 The fool hath said in his heart, There is no GOD.

◇ Psa 6:4 Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh save me for THY mercies' sake.

◇ Psa 6:9 The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer.

+ Psa 7:1 O LORD my GOD, in THEE do I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and deliver me;

Psa 7:10 My defence is of GOD, which saveth the upright in heart.

⇒ Psa 7:17 I will praise the LORD according to HIS righteousness: and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.

◇ Psa 8:1 O LORD our LORD, how excellent is THY Name in all the earth! Who hast set THY GLORY above the heavens.

◇ Psa 8:4 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the Son of Man, that thou visitest him?

◇ Psa 8:5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned HIM with glory and honor

Psa 8:9 O LORD our LORD, how excellent is THY Name in all the earth.

Psalm 15 cont. 3

Psa 15:1 LORD, who shall abide in THY tabernacle? who shall dwell in THY Holy Hill?

◇ Psa 15:2 He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart.

+ → The 16th Psalm is a prediction of the Resurrection of the KING.

Psa 16:1 Preserve me O GOD: for in THEE do I put my trust.

Psa 16:7 I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: ...

◇ Psa 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me: because HE is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

Psa 16:9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

◇ Psa 16:10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine HOLY ONE to see corruption.

→ Psa 17 A prayer of David asking the LORD for help against his enemies.

Psa 17:6 I have called upon THEE, for THOU wilt hear me O GOD: incline thine ear unto me, and hear my speech.

Psalms cont. 4

Psa 17:8 keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of THY wings,

Psa 17:9 From the wicked that oppress me, from my deadly enemies, who compass me about.

Psa 17:15 As for me, I will behold THY Face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with THY likeness.

Psa 18 A song of David thanking the LORD for saving him from his enemies.

Psa 18:6 In my distress, I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my GOD: HE heard my voice out of HIS temple, and my cry came before HIM, even unto HIS ears.

Psa 18:46 The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and let the GOD of my salvation be exalted.

Psa 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in THY sight, O LORD, my strength and my redeemer.

Psa 20:1 The LORD hear thee in the day of trouble; the name of the GOD of Jacob defend thee;

Psa 21 Thanksgiving to the LORD for Victory.

Psalms cont. 6

Psa 24:1 The earth is the LORD's, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

Psa 24:10 Who is this King of Glory? The LORD of Hosts, HE is the KING of Glory. Behold. (CHRIST's Second Advent)

Psa 25 David trusts in the LORD and asks HIM for mercy and forgiveness.

Psa 25:2 O my GOD, I trust in THEE: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.

Psa 25:4 Show me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.

Psa 25:16 Turn thee unto me and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate & afflicted.

Psa 25:18 Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.

Psa 25:20 O keep my soul and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.

Psa 26 David declares his faith in the LORD.

Psa 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psa 27:14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and HE shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Psa 22 David's prayer in a time of Distress.

Psa 22:1 My GOD, my GOD, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me? and from the words of my roaring? Matt 27:46, Mark 15:34

→ Psa 27:1 Words of JESUS on the CROSS.

☒ Psa 22:7 Psalm 22 is a graphic picture of Death by crucifixion.

Psa 22:8 He trusted on the LORD that HE would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him. Matt 27:43

→ Psa 22:11 Be not far from me, for trouble is near; for there is none to help.

→ Psa 22:18 They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture. see Matt 27:35 and Mark 15:24, John 19:24

→ Psa 27:22 I will declare thy name unto Witness my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.

☒ Psa 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee.

☒ Psa 22:28 For the Kingdom is the LORD's: and HE is the governor among the nations.

☒ Psa 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want.

Psa 28:6 Blessed be the LORD, because HE hath heard the voice of my supplications.

Psa 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in HIM, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise HIM.

Psa 29:11 The LORD will give strength unto HIS people; the LORD will bless HIS people with peace.

Psa 30:2 O LORD my GOD, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.

→ Psa 30:3 O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pits.

☒ Psa 30:10 Hear, O LORD, and have mercy upon me: LORD, be thou my helper.

☒ Psa 31:1 In THEE, O LORD, do I put my Trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in THY Righteousness.

Psa 31:3 For THOU art my rock and my fortress; therefore son thy name shall lead me, and guide me.

→ Psa 31:23 O Love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud.

+++ Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, and HE shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.

-> Psalms 32 Confession and forgiveness of sins.

✗ Psalms 32:5 I acknowledged my sin unto THEE, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin.

-> Psalms 33:11 The counsel of the LORD standeth forever, the thoughts of HIS heart to all generations.

✗ Psalms 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose GOD is the LORD, and the people HE has chosen for his own inheritance.

✗ Psalms 33:20 Our soul waiteth for the LORD: HE is our help and our shield.

Psalms 34:4 I sought the LORD and HE heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

Psalms 34:7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear HIM, and delivereth them.

+> Psalms 34:13 Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile.

-> Psalms 34:16 The face of the LORD is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.

-> Psalms 37:11 But the meek shall inherit the earth: and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

* Psalms 37:16 A little that a righteous man hath is better than the riches of many wicked.

✗ Psalms 37:34 Wait on the LORD, and keep HIS way, and HE shall exalt thee to inherit the land, when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see it.

✗ Psalms 37:39 But the salvation of the righteous is of the LORD: HE is their strength in the time of trouble.

-> Psalms 37:40 And the LORD shall keep them, and deliver them: HE shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in HIM.

Psalms 38:15 For in THEE, O LORD, do I hope: THOU wilt hear, O LORD my GOD.

✗ Psalms 38:21 Forsake me not, O LORD: O my GOD, be not far from me.

✗ Psalms 38:22 Make haste to help me, O LORD, my salvation.

✗ Psalms 39:1 I said, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.

Psalms 39:2-6 How fragile is man, and how short is his life.

Psalms 34:17 The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.

Psalms 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; ...

John 19:36 Psalms 34:20 HE keepeth all HIS bones: not one of them is broken. Prediction of CHRIST

-> Psalms 34:22 The LORD redeemeth the soul of HIS servants: and none of them that trust in HIM shall be desolate.

-> Psalms 35 David pleads for the LORD's help.

Psalms 35:1 Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me.

-> Psalms 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in HIS salvation.

Psalms 36:5 Thy mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens, and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds.

Psalms 36:6 Thy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

✗ Psalms 36:9 For with THEE is the fountain of life, in THY light shall we see light.

+> Psalms 37 Trust in the LORD. David's confidence in the LORD.

✗ Psalms 39:13 O spare me, that I may recover strength, before I go hence, and be no more.

Psalms 40 Speaks of Messiah, Jehovah's servant, obedient unto death.

-> Psalms 40:1 I waited patiently for the LORD; and HE inclined unto me, and heard my cry.

Psalms 40:2 HE brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

Psalms 40:4 Blessed is the man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor saith as turn to lies.

Psalms 40:11 Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy loving kindness and thy truth continually preserve me.

✗ Psalms 40:13 Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.

✗ Psalms 40:17 But I am poor and needy; yet the LORD thinketh upon me: THOU art my help and my deliverer; make no tarrying, O my GOD.

-> Psalms 41:1 Blessed is he that considereth the poor: for the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.

* Psalms 41:4 I said, LORD, be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I have sinned against THEE.

Psa 41:9 Yea, mine own familiar friend,
in whom I trusted, which did eat of my
bread, hath lifted up his heel against me.

Psa 41:10 But, Thou O LORD, be merciful
unto me, and raise me up, that I may
requite them.

Psa 41:11 By this I know that thou
savourest me because mine enemy
doth not triumph over me.

Psa 41:13 Blessed be the LORD GOD
of Israel from everlasting unto everlasting,
Amen, and Amen.

Psa 42:2 My soul thirsteth for GOD, for
the living GOD: when shall I come
and appear before GOD?

Psa 43:5 --- hope in GOD: for I shall
yet praise HIM who is the health
of my countenance, and my GOD.

Psa 44:26 Arise for our help, and redeem
us for thy mercies' sake.

* Psa 45 A psalm of the Messich and HIS
advent in glory as the Great King.

→ Psa 46:1 GOD is our refuge and strength,
a very present help in trouble.

☐ Psa 46:10 Be still, and know that I AM GOD:
I will be exalted among the heathen, I will
be exalted in the earth.
