- Act 1:26 Matthias replaces Judas
- Act 2 The HOLY SPIRIT appears to all on the day of Pentecost.
 - Act 2 note - N.T. Summary of the HOLY SPIRIT
 - Act 2:14-36 Peter's sermon announcing the SPIRIT & CHRIST
 - Act 2:36 Peter announces JESUS as both LORD and CHRIST
- Act 2:41-47 The First Church
- Act 3 1st Apostolic miracle. lame man healed
 - Act 4:1-22 First Persecution of Apostles
 - Act 4:23-31 2nd time Christians filled with the HOLY SPIRIT
- Act 5:1-11 Death of Ananias & Saphira over sold land
- Act 5:19 The Angel of the LORD freed the Apostles from prison.
 - Act 5:17-28 2nd persecution of the Apostles
 - Act 5:29... We ought to obey GOD rather than man.
 - Act 5:31-32 Apostles were witnesses of JESUS; and so is also the HOLY GHOST, whom GOD hath given to them that obey HIM.
 - Act 5:34-39 Gamaliel wins council not to kill Apostles. Test that he the work of GOD, not of Judas of Galilee and Theudas
 - Act 5:40-42 Apostles were beaten
- Act 6:1-6 Stephen persecuted. 6:5 the First Deacon & 6:7 O.T. History Summary - Stephen stoned
- Act 7:52... coming of the JUST ONE.
- Act 7:54-60 Stephen, the First Martyr
- Act 11:26... And the disciples were called CHRISTIANS first in Antioch.
 - Act 11:27-30 Agabus
 - Act 12:1-5 Herod... And he killed James the brother of John with the sword
 - Act 12:3-11 Peter released from prison by the Angel of the LORD
 - Act 12:12-14 Peter goes to the house of Mary mother of John Mark to Rhoda let him in
 - Act 12:20-23 Herod killed by the Angel of the LORD
 - Act 13:1-2 Saul and Barnabas called by the Holy Spirit
 - Act 13:3-5 Saul's first missionary journey - to Cyprus
 - Act 13:9-12 Then Saul, (who is also called Paul) filled with the HOLY GHOST, set his eyes on him, and rebuked the devil
 - Act 13:14-17 Paul's sermon at Antioch
 - Act 13:44-45 Paul's teaching rejected by the Jews
 - Act 13:46-49 Paul & Barnabas turn to the Gentiles
 - Act 13:47 For as both the LORD commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldst bring salvation unto the ends of the earth.

- Act 15 Gentiles saved by FAITH, not the Law - MAJOR
 - Peter → Act 15:7-11... why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we are able to bear? But we believe that through the Grace of the LORD JESUS CHRIST we shall be saved, even as they.
 - James → Act 15:13-18 Divine Purpose: the talking out from among the Gentiles of a people hath HIS name (see note)
 - Act 15:19-21 The Gentiles not under the Law, but under GRACE
 - Act 15:28-35 Gentiles must not give offence to Godly Jews
 - Act 15:36-41 Paul leaves Silas, not John Mark
 - Act 16:1-5 Paul binds Timothy
 - Act 16:6... they... were forbidden of the HOLY GHOST to preach the word in Asia
 - Act 16:9 And a vision appeared unto Paul; cousin of a man of Macedonia, Come over into Macedonia and help us.

- Act 8:5-8 Ministry of Phillip
- Act 8:9-25 Simon the Sorcerer
- Act 8:26-40 Phillip and the Ethiopian
- Act 9 The conversion of Paul!
 - Act 9:4-5... Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou ME? ... I AM JESUS whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.
 - Act 9:6... and the LORD said unto him, Arise and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.
 - Act 9:10-16 the LORD appears to Ananias
- Act 9:17 Ananias sent by JESUS to Saul, who became filled with the HOLY SPIRIT
 - Act 9:18 Saul baptized
 - Act 9:20-25 Paul preaches in Damascus
 - Act 9:25 Paul let down by the wall in a basket
 - Act 9:26-29 Paul visits Jerusalem
 - Act 9:32-35 Peter heals Tabernash
 - Act 9:36-43 Peter in JESUS name raises Tabitha from the dead
- Act 10 Gospel given to Gentiles
 - Act 10:1-6 Cornelius' Vision
 - Act 10:9-22 Peter's vision of the great sheet
 - Act 10:35... What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common
 - Act 10:34-35... Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation, he that feareth HIM, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with HIM
 - Act 10:44-48 HOLY SPIRIT given to Gentile Believers
 - Act 10:44 While Peter yet spake these words, the HOLY GHOST fell on all them that heard the Word
 - Act 10:47-48 Gentiles baptized.
- Act 11:17 Forewarned that as God gave them the like gift as HE did unto us, who believed on the LORD JESUS CHRIST; what now is, that I could withstand GOD?

- Act 16:14-15 Lydia becomes First Christian in Europe
 - Act 16:16-18 Paul casts out demon
 - Act 16:19-24 Paul and Silas beaten and cast into prison
 - Act 16:25-29 Earthquake from the LORD
 - Act 16:30-34 Only condition of SALVATION
 - Act 16:31 And they said, Believe on the LORD JESUS CHRIST and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
 - Act 16:35-40 Paul announces he is ROMAN citizen
- Act 17 Founding of the Church at Thessalonica
 - Act 17:15-21 Paul at Athens
 - Act 17:22-34 Paul's sermon from Mars Hill
 - Act 17:23 Paul first altar TO THE UNKNOWN GOD
 - Act 17:34 Dionysius and Damaris were Believers
- Act 18 Founding of Church at Corinth
 - Act 18:9 Then spake the LORD to Paul in the night by a vision: "BE not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace: for I am with thee, and no man shall hurt thee: for I have many people in this city"
 - Act 18:24-28 Apollon at Ephesus instructed by Aquila & Priscilla
- Act 19 Paul at Ephesus: disciples of John become Christians
 - Act 20:6-12 Paul visits Troas (Troy)
 - Act 20:13-16 Paul goes to meat city of Miletus 3,500 B.C.
 - Act 20:17-18 Paul bids farewell to Elders of Ephesus
 - Act 20:35... the work of the LORD JESUS, how he said: "It is more blessed to give than to receive."
- Act 21 Paul goes to Jerusalem
 - Act 21:4-9 HOLY SPIRIT forbids Paul to go to Jerusalem
 - Act 21:10-11 Agabus - HOLY SPIRIT again warns Paul
 - Act 21:27-32 Paul seized in the temple by the Jews
 - Act 21:33-40 Paul bound with chains
 - Act 22 Paul tells of his conversion to the Jews at Jerusalem
 - Act 22:8... I AM JESUS of Nazareth, whom thou persecutest
 - Act 22:21 And he said unto me, Depart: for I will send thee far hence unto the Gentiles
 - Act 22:25-30 Paul declares he is a Roman citizen
 - Act 22:28 And Paul said, But I was FREE born.
