Jas 1:2 My brother count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;
 1:3 Knowing this, that the trying of faith worketh patience
 Jas 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of GOD...
 and it shall be given him.

Jas 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the LORD hath promised to them that love HIM.

Jas 1:14 But every man is tempted, who he is drawn out by his own lusts, and enticed.

Jas 1:15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.
 Jas 1:19 ... let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak,
 slow to wrath:
 1:20 For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of GOD.

Jas 1:22 But he ye doers of the word, and not hearers only.
 1:23-25 forgetful man - i.e. Mirror only

Jas 2:17 Even so, faith, if it hath not works, is dead being alone.

Jas 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Jas 3:5 ... the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things.

Jas 3:8 But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

Jas 3:10 But of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brother, these things ought not so to be.

Jas 3:15-18 Wisdom is from above

Jas 4:6 ... GOD resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

Jas 4:8 Draw nigh to GOD, and HE will draw nigh to you.

Jas 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the LORD, and HE shall lift you up.

Jas 4:14 Whereas you know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.

Jas 4:15 For that ye ought to say, IS THE LORD WILL, we shall live, and do this, or that.

Jas 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

Jas 5:15 And the prayer of Faith shall save the sick, and the LORD shall raise them up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Jas 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.
